LifeGuard RollTek combines side airbag protection with the latest advancements in seatbelt technology. In a rollover, RollTek deploys within a quarter second to minimize driver movement, increase survivable space and cushion head and neck impact, significantly reducing the potential for death or serious injury.

“Of all the fatalities in large commercial trucks, more than half can be attributed to rollovers,” said Larry Gray, General Manager of LifeGuard Technologies. “We are pleased that RollTek side roll protection is now available to Freightliner customers.”

The Cascadia by Freightliner is the first over-the-road truck that is available with LifeGuard RollTek.
